Berdak's life was spent in poverty. The poet writes a lot about his life. Berdak talks about his marital status in the song "Will Summer come":

I don't have a house to sleep on
I have no clothes to wear
We don't have anything from the Turks
Will summer come to our saltiness?

We see from Berdaq's own works and from the words of people who knew the poet that he was very poor and came from a working class. During these years, Berdak learns to read and write. There he will further his knowledge. A sharp memory and hard work will greatly help him to be educated.

A talented poet, a famous bakhshi, was work by the rich and other officials of that time. Because his ancestors and himself were poor, they wanted to destroy the poet. The poet wrote in his work "You don't know" that he was born a poor family.

Brothers, I became a poet,
I was a flower, I turned yellow,
What did I see when I came into the world?
Oh, you know how hard I am.

Despite the fact that Berdak was an intellectual and knowledgeable person of his people, no one honored him at that time, he did not even have respect.

Berdak is a great poet of Karakalpak people. The themes of his works are very rich. In his poetry, an open picture of the social and political life of the Karakalpak people for a whole century is embodied. The main theme of Berdak's works is dedicated to singing the social life of the Karakalpak people, the pitiful hard life. He was the "nightingale of the desert" who shared the joy and sorrow of the people and sang about it.

At the head of the Karakalpak people, Berdak lived in the Era of political inequality, darkness, oppression and adjusting on all sides, and called the people to fight for a free life, honored the good sons of the people, called the youth to be polite, educated, humble, and serve.

In Berdak, the ideas of nationalism and patriotism do not consist of more hopes, confessions, invitations or rhetoric. The idea of nationalism in his works is saturated with specific goals such as struggle, not giving up on the truth, not bowing down to the evil, and if necessary, not to hesitate to sacrifice one's life in this way.
