

FOREIGN BODIES IN THE ANORECTAL AREA

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Foreign bodies are rare in the rectum of children. It is often the result of ingesting bodies along the entire digestive tract from standing in the rectum, or sometimes foreign bodies are formed in the same place (sticking of fruit grains and garbage stones). In rare cases, sharp foreign bodies can be penetrated into the pararectal tissue through the posterior passage.

It is natural for young children to want to swallow what is attached to their hands. Many of them, needles, dikes, nails and hakazos, freely leave the natural path through the Caspian tract. Such transit foreign bodies are not taken into account, but, in more or less observations we made in the rectum, these (needles, dipstick, nails and hakazos) became sharp details of toys, the bone of the fish, that is, sharp pointed bodies. In children who suffer from organic disease of the last part of the large intestine, litter stones are formed from the persistence of products in the intestine. The reason for the formation of rubbish stones is often things that are not treasured (fruit grains). Sometimes overlapping grapes, cherry kernels, etc. can form a conglomerate of large sizes.

Sometimes, through the anus, the child himself can clog a foreign body, which can occur when the penis itches the anal area due to vomiting. Sometimes during medical procedures, foreign bodies in the rectum can be accidentally left behind (enema tube, thermometer).

In our observations, transanal falling objects: a button, toy details, a counting stick, a metal spring, a ballpoint pen and part of a broken glass stick were removed through the anal opening during analysis from the trash.

Thus, in addition to the above, a foreign body can remain standing during a rectum injury. The penetration of foreign bodies into the rectum from various surrounding tissues can be observed, the presence of gauze, sharik, tweezers, which are left in the abdominal operas, and the act of deliberately clogging the foreign bodies from the back release path.



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
