In addition, the success of each education lesson largely depends on the correct Organization of training. The lesson should be based on the creative cooperation of the teacher and the student. Only then will students be able to think independently, and freely, and their will is brought up.

While the Story Chain method helps to grow the oral speech of students in the story Chain, The When Pictures Speak method is much more convenient when teaching English, while the student helps in the development of students' oral speech, using subject-specific pictures for this. "Question potatoes" - "Quiz Cards" are distributed according to the number of students, and all students have the opportunity to participate in the lesson at one time, which saves time. Each innovation technology has its advantages. As a result of the use of innovational methods in English lessons, the logical thinking abilities of students develop, their speech becomes more eloquent, and the skill of quick and correct answers is formed. Such methods instill in the reader a passion for knowledge. The student seeks a thorough preparation for the lessons. Currently, in the process of teaching English, the problem of the formation of creative abilities in adolescents acquires special relevance.
